About Dave Bozell

Dave Bozell always knew he was going to work in the construction technology business. As a child, he would draw sketches of buildings and think about how to make them better. When asked about his love of this industry, he said, "I went straight into it and stayed in it." He followed his passion and graduated from Purdue University with an Associate's degree in Building Construction Management, a Bachelor's degree in Computer Graphics Technology (CGT), and a Master's degree in Industrial Technology. Immediately following, he accepted a position as an Associate Professor in CGT at Purdue University.

Looking back 15 Years

Bozell began CG Visions from his office at Purdue University. He started consulting on integrating light gauge steel panelization 3D BIM software for the creation of dormitories. After this first successful consultation, word and demand increased.

Between 2000 and 2002, the one-man operation grew when Bozell reached out to Cory Shively, Scott Schultz, and Tim Beckman to join his start-up. CG Visions initially worked with apartments, dormitories, and hotels around the country, but saw the opportunity to expand and provide technology-based solutions to help residential home builders. Bozell says, "One of the main priorities of CG Visions is to find holes in processes and then find ways to fix those holes."

With the downturn of the economy in 2008, CG Visions, like many others, struggled during the recession. However, Bozell and CG Visions decided to seize this downturn as an opportunity to "focus on solving the problems that will arise with the return of the economy." Specifically, CG Visions focused on the need to make residential building more efficient and cost-effective. When the economy finally returned, CG Visions was ready to implement new technologies that could help builders do more with less.

Despite the recession, the housing industry is cautiously optimistic and starting to see growth once

again, however is now struggling with a new set of problems.

“Now,” Bozell says, “there is a huge housing shortage and a huge labor shortage. Houses are being sold within weeks or even days of being put on the market. Despite this demand, companies are very wary of hiring and taking risks because of the huge negative downturn of the housing industry a few years ago. [At CG Visions] The question was how can we make the building process both faster and cost effective?” Bozell asks.

His answer is simple: implement new technologies.
